DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 2" LOS ANGELES COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL BRONZED DISK STAMPED "BM108-02120", SET IN THE TOP OF A FLOOD CONTROL CHANNEL WALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE EASTERLY SIDE OF COYOTE CREEK FLOOD CONTROL CHANNEL, 100 FT. NORTHERLY OF A CONCRETE PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE CROSSING THE CHANNEL, 6 FT. WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE BICYCLE PATH ALONG THE EASTERLY LEVEE AND 66 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE PROLONGATION OF ORANGE / WOODSON. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE TOP OF THE WALL.
