EAST OF THE SOUTH OF A CONCRETE HEADWALL OF ORANGE COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL CHANNEL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF MAGNOLIA STREET AND EDINGER AVENUE; 95 FT.
