DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "1J-49-69", SET IN THE TOP OF A 6 IN. BY 6 IN. CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHEASTERLY SIDE OF PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY, 1.1 MILES SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF WARNER AVENUE, 51 FT. NORTHEASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF PCH AND OCS STEEL WITNESS POSTS 1 FT. NORTHERLY AND SOUTHERLY OF MONUMENT. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH PCH AND DOWN 0.3 BELOW DIRT GRADE.
