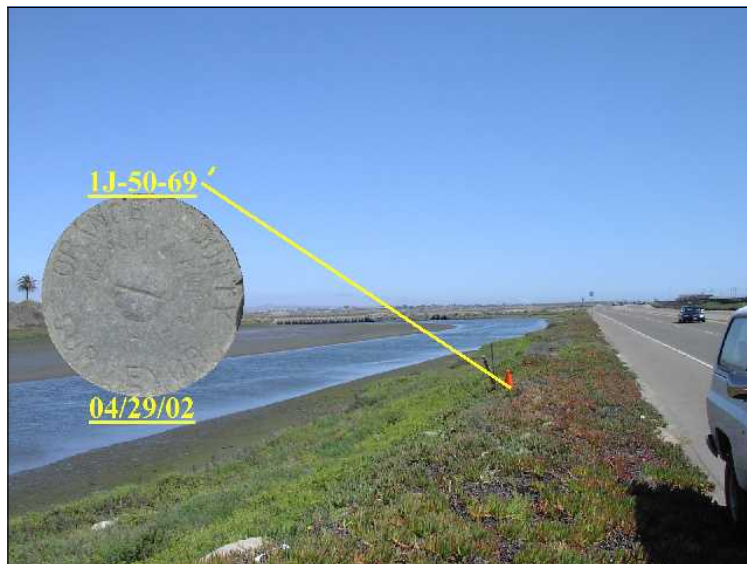

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "1J-50-69", SET IN THE TOP OF A 6 IN. BY 6 IN. CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHEASTERLY SIDE OF PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY, 0.6 MILES SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF WARNER AVENUE, 49 FT. NORTHEASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE NORTHBOUND LANES ALONG PCH AND 1 FT. NORTHWESTERLY OF AN OCS STEEL WITNESS POST. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE GROUND.
