DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "1J-65-83", SET IN THE TOP OF A 6 IN. BY 6 IN. CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHEASTERLY SIDE OF PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY, 1.5 MILES NORTHERLY ALONG PCH FROM THE CENTERLINE OF GOLDENWEST STREET, AT AN ASPHALT ACCESS DRIVEWAY TO THE AMINOIL OIL FIELD, 49 FT.
