DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "1L-62-82", SET IN THE SOUTHERLY END OF A CONCRETE BRIDGE ABUTMENT. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWESTERLY CORNER OF THE ATCHINSON TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY CROSSING OF THE SANTA ANA RIVER, 9.7 FT. WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE RAILWAY AND BETWEEN THE CROSSING OF GLASSELL STREET AND TUSTIN AVENUE ALONG THE SOUTHERLY LEVEE OF THE RIVER. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE TOP OF THE BRIDGE DECK.
