DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "1L-77-87", SET IN THE SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER OF A 9.0 FT. BY 0.9 FT. CONCRETE HEADWALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHERLY LEVEE OF THE SANTA ANA RIVER, 0.95 MILES EASTERLY OF THE IMPERIAL HIGHWAY CROSSING AND 24.3 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE ASPHALT BIKE TRAIL ALONG THE LEVEE. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE TOP OF THE HEADWALL.
