DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" USGS BRONZED BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "278 SB RESET 1943", SET IN THE NORTHWESTERLY CORNER OF A CONCRETE BRIDGE. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE EASTERLY SIDE OF THE ATCHINSON TOPEKA SANTA FE RAILWAY, 0.25 MILES NORTHERLY ALONG CAMINO CAPISTRANO FROM MILE POLE #193, 15 FT. WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF CAMINO CAPISTRANO, 1.2 MILES NORTHERLY ALONG CAMINO CAPISTRANO FROM THE CENTERLINE OF AVERY PARKWAY AND 42 FT. EASTERLY OF THE EASTERLY RAIL ALONG THE RAILWAY. MONUMENT IS SET 0.3 FT. ABOVE THE BRIDGE DECK.
