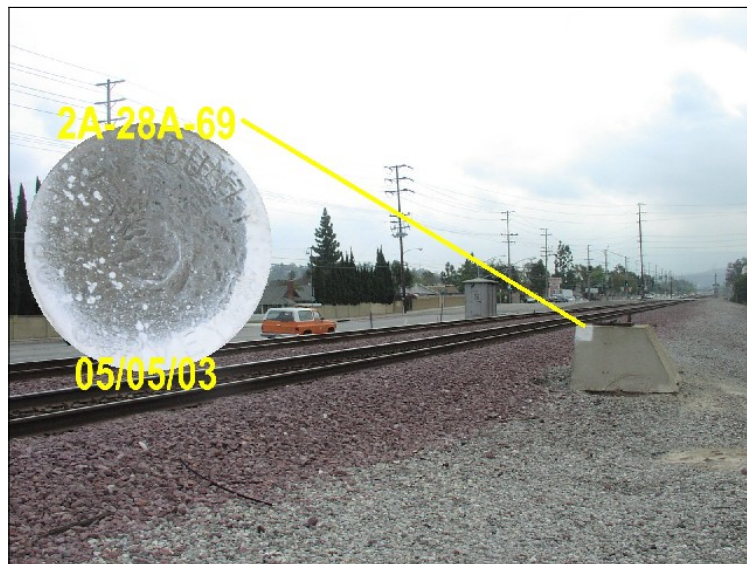

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "2A-28A-69", SET IN THE NORTHWESTERLY CORNER OF AN ABANDONED CONCRETE RAILROAD SIGNAL BASE. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWESTERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF THE ATCHINSON/TOPEKA/SANTA FE RAILWAY AND THE EXTENDED CENTERLINE OF CYMBAL STREET PROLONGED TO THE SOUTH, 201 FT. WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF CYMBAL, 78.8 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE EASTBOUND LANES ALONG ORANGETHORPE AVENUE AND 10.5 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE SOUTHERLY RAIL ALONG THE RAILWAY. MONUMENT IS SET 2.5 FT. ABOVE THE RAILWAY.
