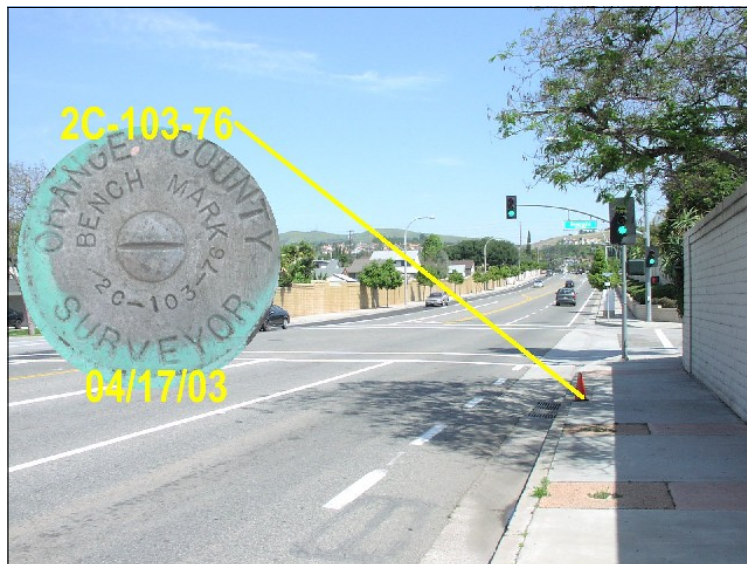

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "2C-103-76", SET IN THE SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER OF A 1.5 FT. BY 8 FT. CONCRETE CATCH BASIN. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF AVOCADO STREET AND STATE COLLEGE BOULEVARD, 33 FT. EASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF STATE COLLEGE AND 72 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF AVOCADO AND 134 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE NORTHERLY RAIL ALONG THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC RAILWAY. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE SIDEWALK.
