DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "2C-75-68", SET IN THE NORTHWESTERLY CORNER OF A CONCRETE EDISON VAULT. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE NORTHEASTERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF CENTRAL AVENUE AND TAMARACK AVENUE, 300 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF CENTRAL, 20 FT. EASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF TAMARACK AND 1.8 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF A 2 FT. TALL STEEL VENT PIPE. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE TOP OF THE VAULT.
