DESCRIBED BY OCS 2014 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM DISK STAMPED "BENCHMARK 2C-89-70", SET IN THE WESTERLY END OF A CONCRETE HEADWALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF IMPERIAL HIGHWAY, 0.25 MILES WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF ROSE DRIVE TO A CONCRETE FLOOD CHANNEL UNDERCROSSING OF IMPERIAL, 60 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF IMPERIAL HIGHWAY AND 1.5 FT. WESTERLY OF A STEEL FENCE POST FOR A 5 FT. CHAIN LINK FENCE. MONUMENT IS SET +/- 20 FT. BELOW IMPERIAL HIGHWAY.
