DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3B-105-91", SET IN THE TOP SOUTHWESTERLY CORNER OF A CONCRETE BRIDGE ABUTMENT. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ON THE NORTHWESTERLY SIDE OF A FLOOD CONTROL CHANNEL AND SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE ATCHINSON TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY, 0.3 MILES NORTHERLY ALONG THE RAILWAY FROM ITS CENTERLINE CROSSING OF HARVARD AND 15 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE SOUTHWESTERLY RAIL. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE ABUTMENT
