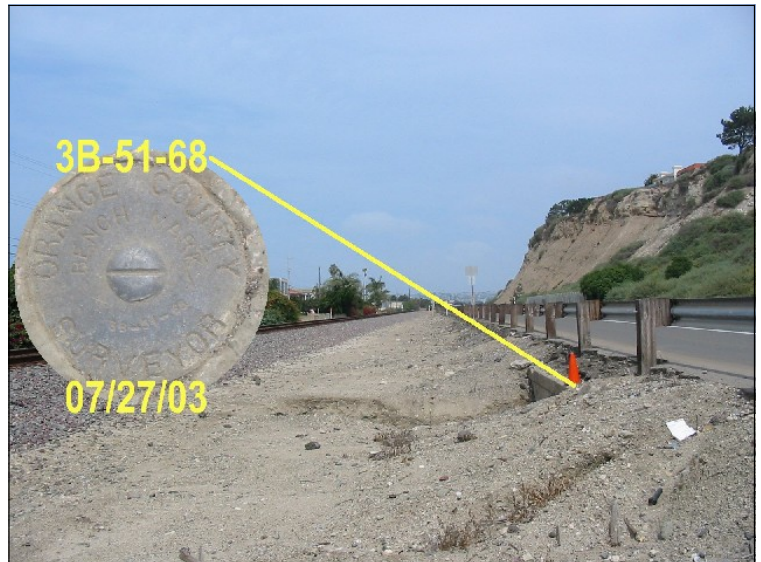

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3B-51-68", SET IN THE TOP OF A CONCRETE HEADWALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE SOUTHWESTERLY SIDE OF EL CAMINO REAL, 1.3 MILES SOUTHWESTERLY FROM THE CENTERLINE OF HIGHWAY 1, 27.6 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF EL CAMINO REAL AND ACROSS FROM A LARGE STONE STAIRCASE LEADING TO THE TOP OF THE BLUFF. MONUMENT IS SET 1.2 FT. LOWER THAN THE ROAD.
