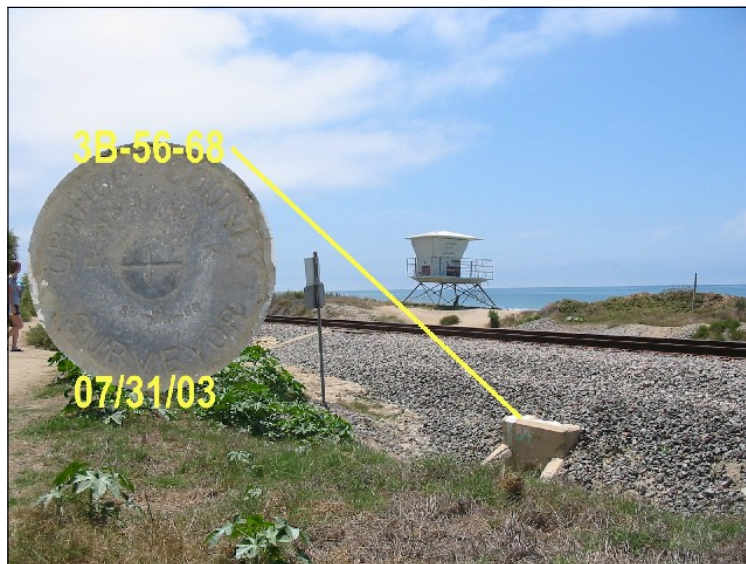

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3B-56-68", SET IN THE SOUTHERLY END OF A CONCRETE HEADWALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHEASTERLY SIDE OF THE ATCHINSON TOPEKA SANTA FE RAILWAY, 0.8 MILES SOUTHERLY OF THE SAN CLEMENTE PIER, 92.8 FT. NORTHERLY AND ACROSS THE TRACKS FROM LIFEGUARD TOWER #5 AND 49.5 FT. SOUTHEASTERLY OF A FOOT PATH LEADING UP A BLUFF. MONUMENT IS SET 1.3 FT. BELOW THE HEIGHT OF THE TRACKS.
