DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3B-78-73", SET IN THE TOP OF A 6 IN. BY 6 IN. CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE WESTERLY SIDE OF THE ATCHINSON TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY, 0.5 MILES NORTHERLY ALONG THE RAILWAY FROM THE BRIDGE CROSSING TRABUCO CREEK, 22 FT. WESTERLY OF THE WESTERLY RAIL AND 1 FT. WESTERLY OF A STEEL OCS WITNESS POST. MONUMENT IS SET 2.0 FT. BELOW THE RAILWAY.
