DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3B-91-82", SET IN THE NORTHERLY END OF A CONCRETE HEADWALL FOR A BOX CULVERT CROSSING UNDER THE ATCHINSON/TOPEKA/SANTA FE RAILWAY. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE WESTERLY SIDE OF THE RAILWAY, 14 FT. WESTERLY OF THE WESTERLY RAIL AND 0.7 MILES NORTHERLY ALONG THE RAILWAY FROM THE OVERCROSSING OF THE (5 FREEWAY). MONUMENT IS SET 6 FT. LOWER THAN THE RAILWAY.
