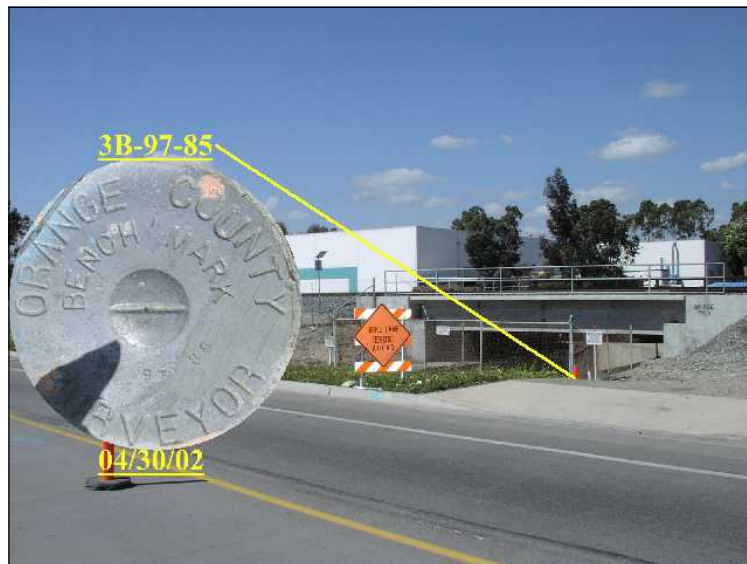

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3B-97-85", SET IN THE SOUTHEASTERLY END OF A 1 FT. BY 24 FT. CONCRETE HEADWALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHEASTERLY SIDE OF EDINGER AVENUE, 0.75 MILES NORTHWESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF HARVARD AVENUE, 66 FT. NORTHEASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF EDINGER AND 52 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE SOUTHWEST RAIL ALONG THE ATCHINSON TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY. MONUMENT IS SET 7.0 FT. BELOW THE RAILROAD TRACKS.
