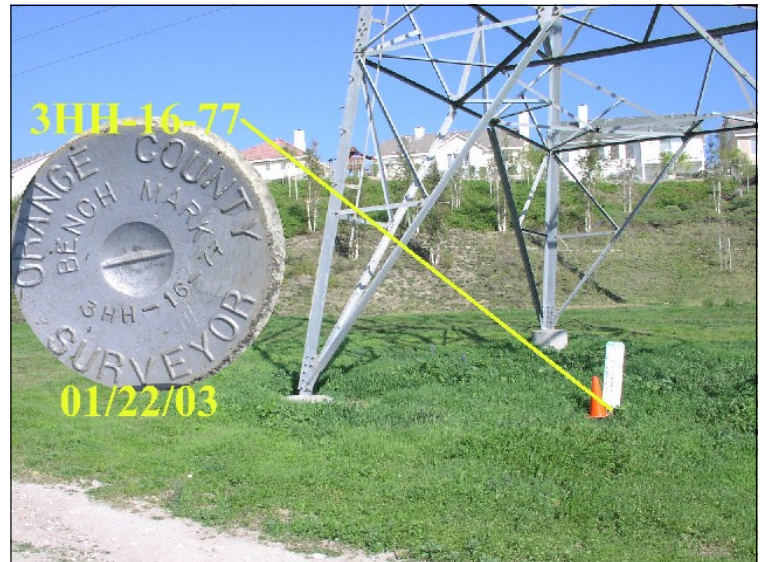

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3HH-16-77" SET IN A CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED JUST NORTHEAST OF THE INTERSECTION OF OLYMPIAD ROAD AND STONEGATE AND IS UNDER THE WESTERLY SIDE OF A HIGH VOLTAGE TOWER #19-5), BETWEEN THE WESTERLY LEGS, 450 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF STONEGATE AND 120 FT. EASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF OLYMPIAD ROAD. MONUMENT IS SET UP 0.3 FT. ABOVE THE GROUND.
