DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3K-24A-82", SET IN THE TOP OF A CONCRETE BRIDGE DECK. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY AND NEWPORT BAY CROSSING, 42 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF PCH AND 37 FT. EASTERLY OF THE WEST END OF THE SOUTHERN GUARD RAIL ALONG BRIDGE. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE SIDEWALK.
