DESCRIBED BY OCS 2001 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3N-50-70", SET IN THE TOP OF A CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF BRISTOL STREET AND SANTA ANA/REDHILL AVENUE, 78 FT. SOUTHEASTERLY FROM THE SOUTHEAST END OF THE SOUTHERLY CURB RETURN, AND 6 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF A 3 FT. FIRE HYDRANT AND AT THE NORTHERLY END OF A 2.5 FT. BLOCK WALL DIVIDING TWO PROPERTIES. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE SIDEWALK.
