MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE EASTERLY SIDE OF ORTEGA HIGHWAY, 8.65 MILES EASTERLY ALONG ORTEGA FROM THE INTERSTATE 5 FREEWAY, 4 MILES SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE SAN JUAN FIRE STATION, 65.0 FT. SOUTHERLY OF A CENTERLINE POINT MARKED SECTION LINE AND WITH AN OCS PADDLEBOARD AT THE SOUTHWESTERLY SIDE OF THE INLET. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE TOP OF THE DROP INLET.
