FROM THE MAIN ENTRANCE TO O'NEILL PARK, PROCEED 1.3 MILES SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG LIVE OAK CANYON ROAD TO PLANO TRABUCO ROAD, PROCEED 1 MILE SOUTH ON PLANO TRABUCO ROAD TO THE MAIN ENTRANCE TO COTO DE CAZA, FOLLOW THE PAVED ROAD 1.7 MILES SOUTH INTO COTO DE CAZA TO A 90 DEGREE CURVE IN THE ROAD AT THE MAIN RODEO AREA AND BOARDING BARN, 23 FT. NORTH WEST OF THE NORTHWEST EDGE OF THE PAVEMENT ALONG THE OUTSIDE OF THE CURVE 25 FT. WEST OF THE CENTERLINE OF A DIRT ROAD THAT LEADS TO THE AREA, 5.5 FT. SOUTHWEST OF A WOODEN "WHOA" SIGN, 7 FT.
