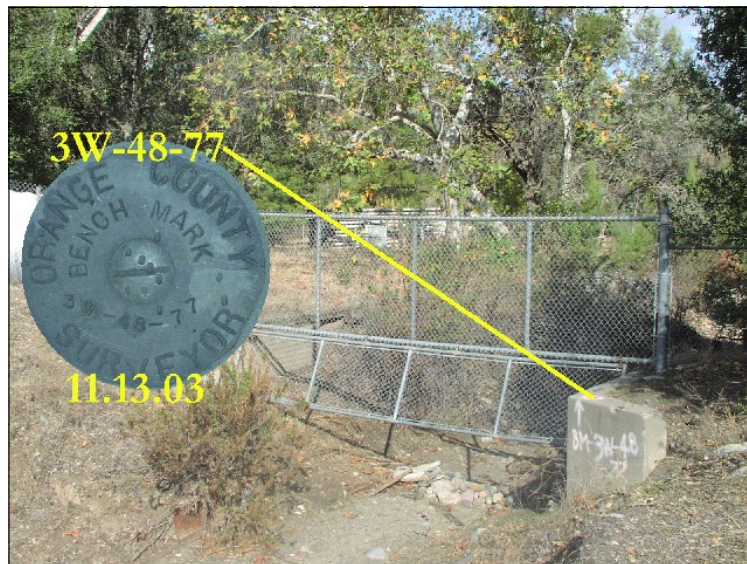

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3W-48-77", SET IN THE TOP OF A CONCRETE HEADWALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED INSIDE ONEILL REGIONAL PARK, FROM THE TRABUCO CANYON ROAD ENTRANCE TO ONEILL PARK PROCEED .60 MILES NORTHEASTERLY ALONG ASPHALT ROAD TO THE TURN-OFF FOR EAST CAMPGROUND GROUP, THEN PROCEED .15 MILES ALONG ROAD TO WHERE THE ROAD CROSSES THE CREEK AND THERE ARE 16 WHITE POLES ALONG THE EDGE OF THE ROAD, 100 FT. WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD AND 200 +/- NORTHERLY FROM THE NORTHERLY END OF THE LINE OF POLES. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE TOP OF THE WALL.
