DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3\4" US ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS BRONZE DISK STAMPED "CC 6 1957", SET IN THE EASTERLY END OF A CONCRETE BRIDGE. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE EASTERLY PORTION OF THE INTERSECTION OF CERRITOS AVENUE AND THE COYOTE CREEK OVERCROSSING, 1.0 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF CERRITOS AVENUE AND 120 FT. EASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE COYOTE CREEK CHANNEL. MONUMENT IS SET 1.0 FT. ABOVE THE ROAD.
