MONUMENT IS LOCATED 1.15 MILES NORTHEASTERLY ALONG BREA BOULEVARD FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH STATE COLLEGE BOULEVARD TO A PAVED ROAD LEADING EASTERLY, 1100 FT. EASTERLY ALONG ROAD, 17 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD, 22 FT. WESTERLY OF A CONCRETE HEADWALL AND 17 FT. EASTERLY OF A 48 INCH PEPPER TREE. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE ROAD
