DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" USC&GS BRONZED DISK STAMPED "H 786 1946", SET IN THE TOP OF A CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE EASTERLY SIDE OF LAGUNA CANYON ROAD, 1.97 MILES SOUTHERLY ALONG STATE HIGHWAY 133 FROM THE INTERSECTION OF OLD LAGUNA CANYON ROAD, 49 FT. EASTERLY OF HIGHWAY 133, 1.2 FT. NORTHWESTERLY OF A 4 FT. TALL BARBED WIRE FENCE, 1.5 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF AN OCS WITNESS POST AND 15.5 FT. NORTHERLY OF A 48 IN. TREE. MONUMENT IS SET 4.5 FT. ABOVE THE HIGHWAY 133.
