DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "HB-255-83", SET IN THE TOP OF A FLOOD CONTROL CHANNEL WALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF EDINGER AVENUE AND THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC RAILROAD CROSSING, 0.5 MILES WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF BEACH BOULEVARD, 92.2 NORTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF EDINGER AVENUE, AND 37.5 FT. EASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE MAIN TRACK ALONG THE RAILWAY. MONUMENT IS SET DOWN 1.0 FT. FROM ROAD SURFACE.
