DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3\4" USCGS BRONZED DISK STAMPED "J 784 1946", SET IN THE SOUTHERLY END OF A 2 FT. BY 8 FT. CONCRETE HEADWALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE WESTERLY SIDE OF THE

ATCHINSON/TOPEKA/SANTA FE RAILWAY, 0.3 MILES NORTHERLY ALONG THE RAILWAY FROM THE EL TORO ROAD CROSSING TO A DOUBLE 24 IN. CORRUGATED METAL PIPE CULVERT CROSSING BELOW THE TRACKS AND 0.7 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE SOUTHERLY END OF THE WALL. MONUMENT IS SET 5 FT. BELOW THE TRACKS LEVEL.
