REPORTED DESTROYED (SEE DATE IN DESTROYED BOX) - ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION BEING: DESCRIBED BY OCS 1968 1.6 MILES SOUTHEAST ALONG THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY FROM THE STATION AT IRVINE, 0.5 MILE SOUTHEAST OF MILE POLE 184 AT THE CROSSING OF AN ABANDONED PAVED ROAD, IN THE TOP OF THE SOUTHWEST END OF THE NORTHWEST CONCRETE ABUTMENT OF A OLD RAILWAY BRIDGE, (THE BRIDGE HAS BEEN COVERED WITH FILL, ALL THAT REMAINS IS THE CONCRETE ABUTMENTS), 24 FT. SOUTHEAST OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD, 5.8 FT. SOUTHWEST OF THE SOUTHWEST RAIL, 5 FT. NORTHEAST OF THE EAST CORNER OF THE CONCRETE FOUNDATION FOR SIGNAL CONTROL BOX, 120 FT.
