DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" NGS BRONZE DISK STAMPED "N 371 1949", SET IN THE NORTHERLY END OF A 3.5 FT. TALL CONCRETE WALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF SEAL BEACH BOULEVARD AND FORRESTAL AVENUE, 0.7 MILE NORTHEAST ALONG SEAL BEACH BOULEVARD FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY, AT THE MAIN ENTRANCE TO THE U.S. NAVAL WEAPONS STATION, 140 FT. SOUTHEAST OF THE SOUTHEAST CURB OF SEAL BEACH BOULEVARD, 20 FT. SOUTHWEST OF THE WESTERLY CORNER OF THE GUARD HOUSE. MONUMENT IS UP 3.5 FT. ABOVE THE GROUND LEVEL. NOTE- BENCHMARK IS INSIDE AN 8 FT. HIGH SECURITY FENCE.
