REPORTED DESTROYED (SEE DATE IN DESTROYED BOX) - ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION BEING: ORIGINALLY DESCRIBED BY OCS FROM THE CITY OF SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO GO 5.3 MILES EASTERLY ALONG ORTEGA HIGHWAY (STATE HIGHWAY 74) FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE SAN DIEGO FREEWAY (INTERSTATE 5) TO A PAVED ROAD ON THE LEFT.(DIRECTLY ACROSS FROM A REMOTE CONTROL CHAIN LINK GATE), TURN LEFT AND GO 0.4 MILE NORTH ON THE PAVED ROAD TO A FORK IN THE ROAD, TAKE THE RIGHT FORK AND GO 0.2 OF MILE NORTH ON THE PAVED ROAD TO A DIRT ROAD ON THE LEFT, TURN LEFT AND GO 0.8 MILE WESTERLY ON THE DIRT ROAD AS IT FOLLOWS ALONG THE BASE OF A HILL TO A DIRT ROAD ON THE RIGHT THAT LEADS TO CANADA GOBERNADORA, TURN RIGHT AND GO 1.65 MILES NORTH OF THE DIRT ROAD TO AN IRON GATE, THE MARK IS 121 FT. NORTH OF THE GATE, 15 FT. WEST OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE DIRT ROAD, 2 FT. EAST OF A BARBED WIRE FENCE, 27 FT.
