

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" USCGS BRONZED DISK STAMPED "N 786 1946", SET IN THE BOTTOM PORTION OF A LARGE ROCK OUTCROPPING SLOPED DOWN TO THE EAST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE NORTHWESTERLY PORTION OF THE INTERSECTION OF LAGUNA CANYON ROAD (STATE HIGHWAY 133) AND EL TORO ROAD, 200 FT. NORTHWESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE INTERSECTION OF EL TORO ROAD AND THE 133 HIGHWAY TO A 50 FT. BY 30 FT. ROCK OUTCROPPING SLOPED DOWN TO THE EAST AND IN THE NORTHEASTERLY PORTION OF THE SAID ROCK OUTCROPPING. MONUMENT IS SET 2.5 FT. HIGHER THAN THE GROUND.
