

Description:

Due to RR construction (ballast was raised and wood retaining wall was installed) it is not possible to plumb a rod over point. DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3\4" NGS BRONZE DISK STAMPED "R 781 1946", SET IN THE SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER OF A CONCRETE BRIDGE. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF THE ATCHINSON TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILROAD AND THE SANTIAGO CREEK **OVERCROSSING, 0.1 MILES NORTHERLY ALONG** THE RAILWAY FROM THE CENTERLINE OF FAIRHAVEN AVENUE, 2 FT. EASTERLY OF THE **EASTERLY RAIL AND 8.5 FT. WESTERLY OF THE** EASTERLY END OF THE SOUTHEAST BRIDGE ABUTMENT. MONUMENT IS SET 2.0 FT. BELOW THE TRACKS.
