DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" US COAST AND GEODETIC SURVEY BRONZED DISK STAMPED "T 424 R 70", SET IN THE SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER OF A 3 FT. BY 3.2 FT. CONCRETE CATCH BASIN. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE NORTHWESTERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF BREA BOULEVARD AND THE CENTERLINE OF EASTWOOD PLACE PROLONGED TO THE EAST, 46 FT. WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF BREA AND 9 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE PROLONGATION OF EASTWOOD. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE SIDEWALK.
