DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" US COAST AND GEODETIC SURVEY BRONZED DISK STAMPED "W-348", SET IN THE TOP OF A 1 FT. BY 1 FT. CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE EASTERLY SIDE OF BREA BOULEVARD, 0.75 MILES NORTHEASTERLY ALONG BREA FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH TONNER CANYON ROAD, 31 FT. SOUTHEASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF BREA, 85 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF BENCHMARK (#V-348) AND 1.5 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF A STEEL WITNESS POST UP 1.5 FT. MONUMENT IS SET 5 FT. BELOW THE ROAD SURFACE.
