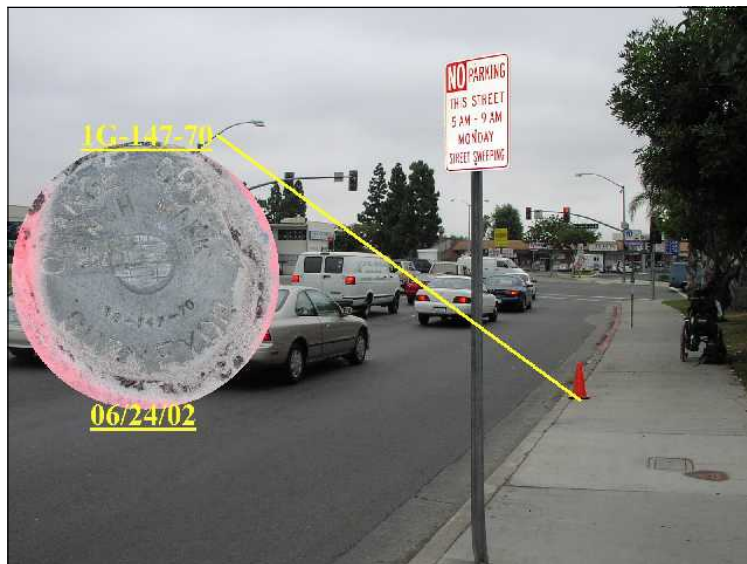

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "1G-147-70", SET IN THE TOP OF A 6 IN. BY 6 IN. CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE NORTHWESTERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF GARDEN GROVE BOULEVARD AND MAGNOLIA STREET, 142 FT.
