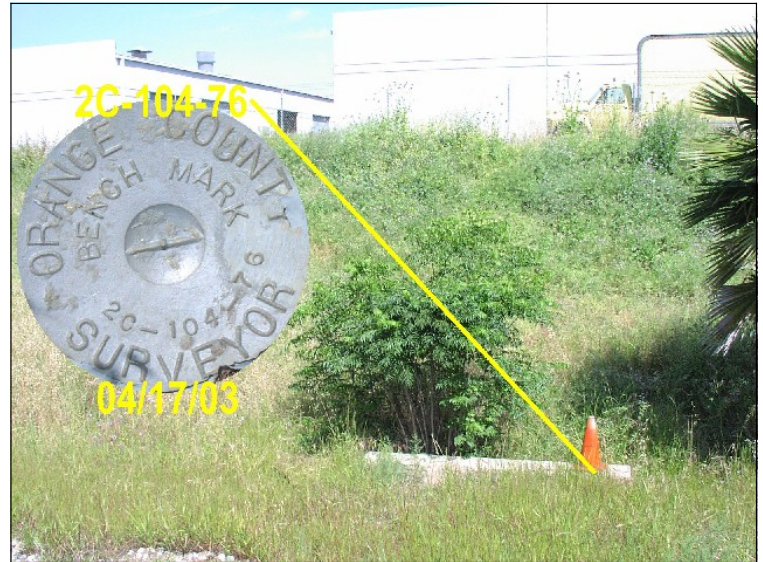

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "2C-104-76", SET IN THE EASTERLY END OF A CONCRETE HEADWALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC RAILWAY, 260 FT. WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF RANDOLPH AVENUE PROJECTED FROM THE SOUTH, 26.2 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE NORTHERLY RAIL ALONG THE RAILWAY. MONUMENT IS SET 2.5 FT. BELOW THE SURFACE OF THE TRACKS.
