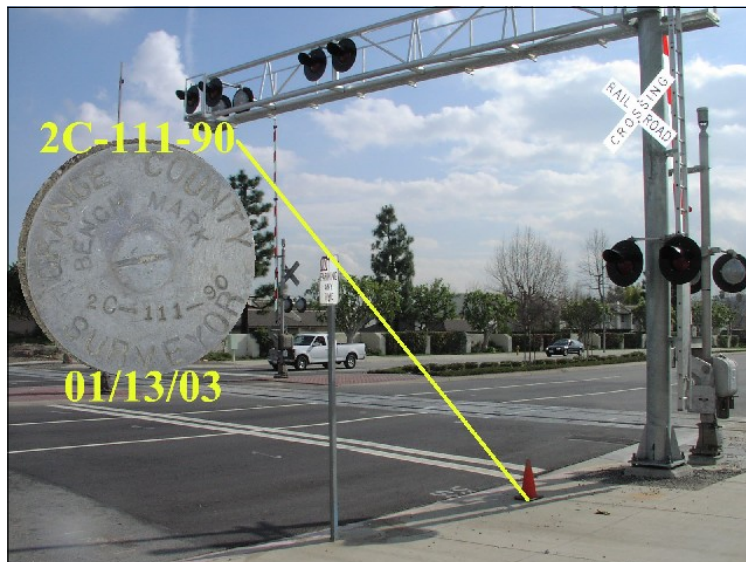

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "2C-111-90", SET IN THE SOUTHWESTERLY CORNER OF A 3 FT. BY 8 FT. CONCRETE CATCH BASIN. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE WESTERLY SIDE OF BEACH BOULEVARD, 0.3 MILES NORTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF LAMBERT ROAD TO A RAILWAY CROSSING, 28 FT. NORTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE RAILROAD, 58 FT. WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF BEACH BOULEVARD AND 43 FT. SOUTHEASTERLY OF THE SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER OF A 10 FT. HIGH BLOCK WALL. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE SIDEWALK.
