DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "2C-71-68", SET IN THE TOP OF A CONCRETE FOOTING FOR A 6 FT. TALL BRICK WALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWESTERLY CORNER OF THE "T" INTERSECTION OF LA HABRA BOULEVARD AND NORTH COLLEGE, 48 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF LA HABRA, 88 FT.
