DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "2C-77-69", SET IN THE EASTERLY END OF A CONCRETE WINGWALL. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE WESTERLY SIDE OF VAN BUREN STREET, 436 FT. SOUTHERLY ALONG VAN BUREN FROM THE CENTERLINE OF THE ATCHINSON/TOPEKA/SANTA FE RAILWAY TO A CONCRETE BRIDGE OVER A FLOOD CHANNEL, 20.5 FT. WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF VAN BUREN AND 2 FT. WESTERLY OF THE NORTHWESTERLY CORNER OF THE BRIDGE. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE STREET.
