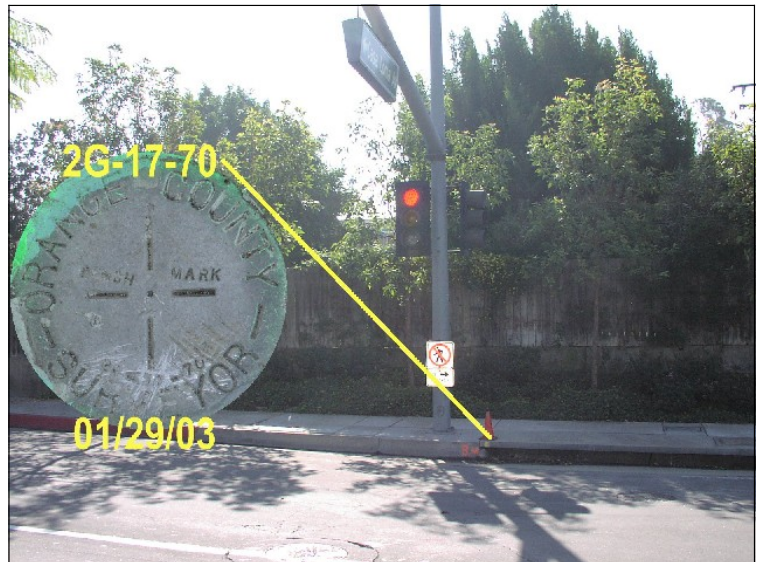

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "2G-17-70", SET IN THE NORTHEASTERLY CORNER OF A 4 FT. BY 15 FT. CONCRETE CATCH BASIN. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHEASTERLY PORTION OF THE INTERSECTION OF YORBA LINDA BOULEVARD AND CASA LOMA AVENUE TO THE NORTH, 3 FT. NORTHWESTERLY OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL POLE, 36 FT. EASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE PROD OF CASA LOMA TO THE NORTH AND 42.5 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF YORBA LINDA BOULEVARD. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE SIDEWALK.
