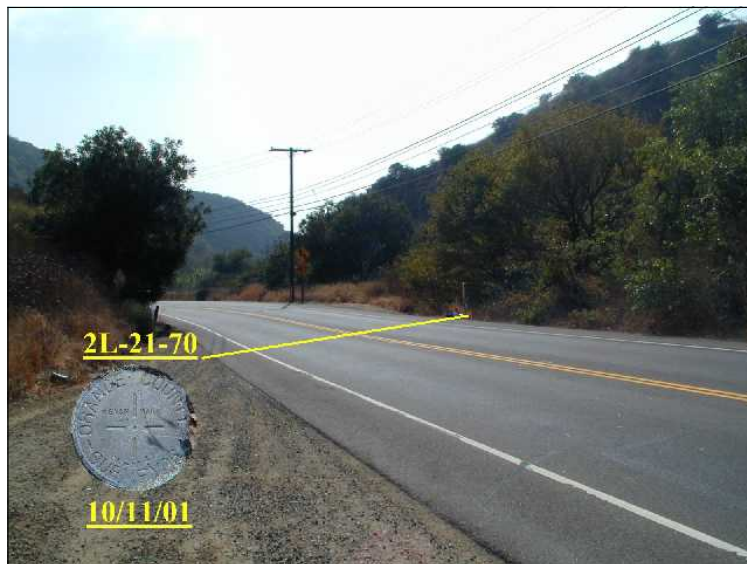

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2001 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "2L-21-70", SET IN THE TOP OF A CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE WESTERLY SIDE OF CARBON CANYON ROAD NEAR CONSTRUCTION MARKER "142 ORA 5-47", 147.8 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF TELEPHONE POLE #625056, 14 FT. NORTHEASTERLY OF THE CENTER OF A METAL PIPE CULVERT, 7.6 FT. NORTHEASTERLY OF THE CONSTRUCTION STATION MARKER, 21 FT. NORTHWESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD AND 2 FT. WESTERLY OF AN OCS STEEL WITNESS POST. MONUMENT IS SET 1 FT. HIGHER THAN THE ROAD.
