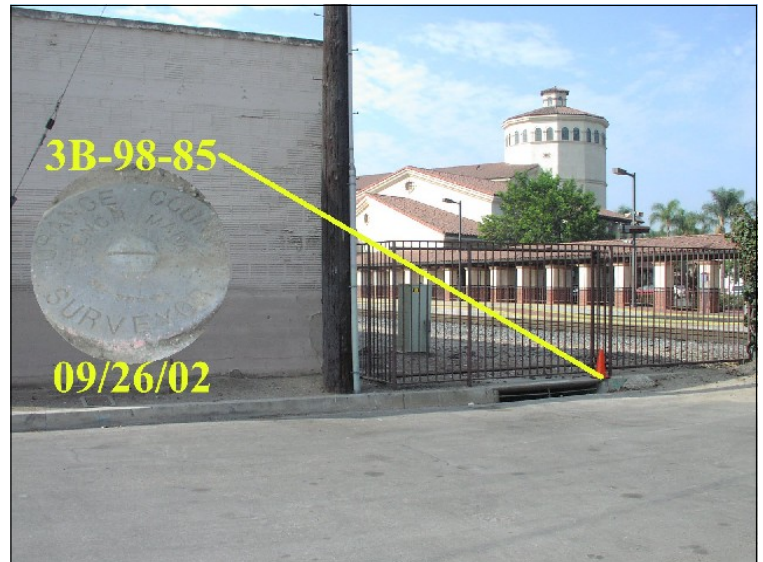

DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3B-98-85", SET IN THE NORTHWESTERLY CORNER OF A 4 FT. BY 8 FT. CONCRETE CATCH BASIN. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF FRUIT STREET AND THE ATCHINSON TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILROAD, 23 FT. EASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE RAILWAY, 19.5 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF FRUIT STREET AND 14.3 FT. WEST OF A POWER POLE (#716815E").
