DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3B-99-85", SET IN THE EASTERLY END OF THE SOUTHERLY ABUTMENT FOR A CONCRETE BRIDGE CROSSING OF A REINFORCED CONCRETE DOUBLE BOX. MONUMENT IS LOCATED 2.5 MILES NORTHERLY ALONG THE ATCHINSON TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY FROM THE STATION AT SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO, 0.25 MILES NORTHERLY OF MILE POLE #195 ALONG RAILWAY AND 87 FT. WESTERLY OF THE WESTERLY RAIL ALONG THE RAILWAY. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE TOP OF THE WALL.
