DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3F-98-70", SET IN THE TOP OF THE NORTHEASTERLY CONCRETE FOOTING FOR A HIGH POWERED TRANSMISSION LINE TOWER. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF EL TORO ROAD, 600 FT. WESTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF ALISO CREEK ROAD, 98 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF EL TORO ROAD AND 400 FT. SOUTHERLY AND ACROSS EL TORO ROAD FROM THE EDISON TRANSFORMER STATION.
