DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3L-49-92", SET IN THE SOUTHERLY CORNER OF A 2 FT. BY 2 FT. CONCRETE PAD WITH A 2 FT. HIGH VENT PIPE. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHEASTERLY SIDE OF SANTIAGO CANYON ROAD, 0.3 MILES SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF LOLITA STREET, AND 45 FT. EASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF SANTIAGO CANYON ROAD. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE TOP OF THE PAD. NOTE: CONCRETE PAD IS FAILING UNDER MONUMENT.
