DESCRIBED BY OCS 2002 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3PP-4-81", SET IN THE NORTHWESTERLY CORNER OF A 6.5 FT BY 5.5 FT. CONCRETE VAULT. MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWESTERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF ALICIA PARKWAY AND OLYMPIAD ROAD, 52 FT. SOUTHERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF ALICIA, 20 FT. WESTERLY OF THE WESTERLY END OF THE SOUTHWESTERLY CURB RETURN AND ON LINE BETWEEN TWO 2.5 FT. TALL STEEL VENT PIPES. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE SIDEWALK.
