DESCRIBED BY OCS 2013 - FOUND 3 3/4" OCS ALUMINUM BENCHMARK DISK STAMPED "3W-24-72", SET IN THE TOP OF A 6 IN. BY 6 IN. CONCRETE POST. MONUMENT IS LOCATED ALONG THE NORTHEASTERLY SIDE OF ORTEGA HIGHWAY, 1.8 MILES EASTERLY ALONG ORTEGA FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH ANTONIO PARKWAY, 5 FT. SOUTHWESTERLY OF A BARBED WIRE FENCE, 2.6 FT. SOUTHEAST FROM A BURNT WOOD FENCE POST, AND 1 FT. NORTHWESTERLY OF A STEEL WITNESS POST. MONUMENT IS SET UP 0.6 FT. ABOVE THE GROUND.
