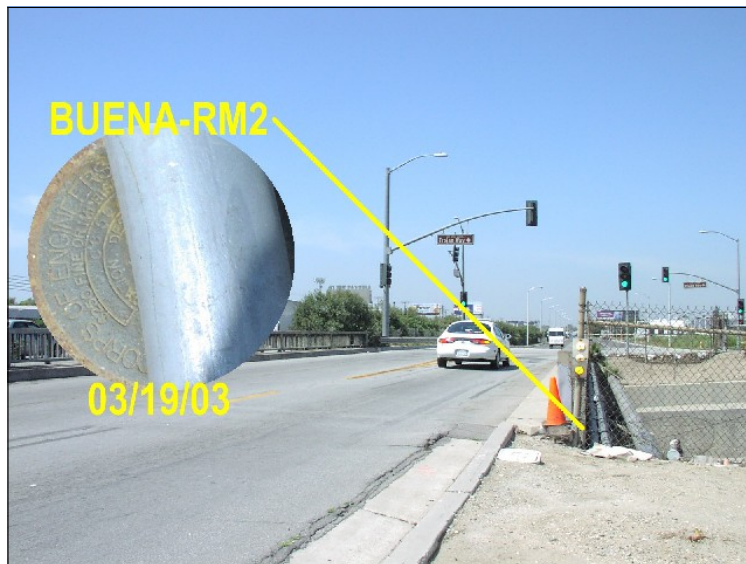

NOTE: MARK HAS 2 IN. STEEL CONDUIT RUNNING DIRECTLY OVER MARK MAKING IT INACCESSIBLE. DESCRIBED BY OCS 2003 - FOUND 3 3/4" US ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEER BRONZED DISK STAMPED "BUENA RM2", SET IN THE TOP OF A CONCRETE BRIDGE ABUTMENT, MONUMENT IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF FIRESTONE BOULEVARD AND THE COYOTE CREEK UNDERCROSSING, 14.4 FT. SOUTHEASTERLY OF THE CENTERLINE OF FIRESTONE AND AT THE SOUTHERLY END OF THE EASTERLY GUARD RAIL ALONG BRIDGE. MONUMENT IS SET LEVEL WITH THE BRIDGE DECK.
